From colorful collaborations to can't-miss solo shows across the globe, *CULTURED* brings you the latest on what's happening in art this week.

David Zwirner is presenting a solo exhibition of works by Elizabeth Peyton at the gallery's London outpost. The artist is best known for her intimate portraits of celebrities and personal friends. The exhibition's title, "Angel," was inspired by the Ancient Greek term *angelos*, a messenger or protector. Here, Peyton turns her subjects into something akin to these mythical beings, bathing them in light and rendering them with a delicate touch. "Angel" will be on view from June 7 to July 28, 2023 at David Zwirner in London.

***"Identidad Perdida"* by Juan Pablo Echeverri**

James Fuentes is presenting Juan Pablo Echeverri's "*Identidad Perdida*," a solo exhibition in two parts that displays the Colombian artist's prolific body of work, often read as a continuous self-portrait that began in adolescence. The exhibit's title translates to "lost identity," a nod to the late artist's challenge of the flattened and stereotypical Latinx identity markers. The show includes more than 400 images that serve to showcase this photographic provocation.

"Identidad Perdida" will be on view from June 7 to July 28, 2023 at James Fuentes in New York.
